Background

It is a tradition of the African Union (AU) to celebrate African Integration during July of every year. The premier event for showcasing the successes achieved so far on the integration journey is the Boma of Africa, which in 2023 will be hosted in hybrid format and streamed from the Headquarters of the African Union Commission (AUC).

4D Pact

The emphasis of Boma 2023 is the signing of the 4D Pact (pact.4DCorridor.org) by leading Pan-African institutions. The 4D Pact is a commitment to work together to promote and resource large-scale platforms and accelerators of the innovations at public and private sector level urgently needed to transform Africa according to Agenda 2063: the Africa we want.

A New Strategy for Speeding Up Agenda 2063

With technical support from AfroChampions, the AUC will support the inaugural sponsors of the 4D Pact – the Africa Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (Africa CDC), the African Civil Aviation Commission (AFCAC), the AfCFTA Secretariat, the African Union Development Agency – New Partnership for African Development (AUDA-NEPAD), and the Africa Capacity Building Foundation (ACBF) – to mobilise development finance institutions (DFIs), multilateral development agencies, AU Member States, corporations, and other important continental and global stakeholders to ramp up the pace of African integration through Agenda 2063 flagships and related instruments.

AU Flagships to be Accelerated

Key flagships to be accelerated by the 4D Pact include the Africa Continental Free Trade Agreement (AfCFTA), the Protocol on Free Movement of People (PFMP), the Single African Air Transport Market (SAATM), the Partnerships for African Vaccine Manufacturing (PAVM) and others.

4D Instruments

Through the resourcing and promotion mechanisms of the 4D Initiative (www.4DCorridor.org), platforms and accelerators like BioNovac, the AfCFTA Hub, ProPer, the African Public Health Wallet (PanaBIOS-Trusted Health), and the Green Economy Transforma, will be scaled up into an marketplace-ecosystem of innovation through which resources and support can be channeled by DFIs, Social Venture Funds and development agencies.

Beneficiaries of the initiative will include startups, SMEs, university spinoffs and commercialization offices, and national investment promotion and small business support agencies.

Concrete outcomes over the next seven years include:

- Growing evidence of biotech value chain activities on the continent leading to more advanced biomedical, vaccine, biopharmaceutical, e-genomics and biosecurity outputs from African based entities with a material impact on jobs, skills, knowledge creation, and well-being.
- Enhanced mobility of businesses and skilled professionals across Africa in the pursuit of richer opportunities.
- Reduction in the prevalence of energy poverty on the continent through a more strategic use of climate-smart finance for transitional energy infrastructure.
